Freelance Live Sound Engineer. 1981-1983.

Mostly for Nana Mouskouri (World famous Greek singer during the 70's and 80's) the job entailed lengthy overseas tours with a largely acoustic group, mixing front of house sound in venues ranging from small clubs to ice-hockey stadiums.

Britannia Row Audio. 1979-1981.

Front of house engineer mixing a large variety of bands including Randy Newman, Dionne Warwick, Carla Bley and many jazz and rock festivals. I became Pink Floyd's front of house engineer for 'The Wall' shows at Earl's Court in London, using 150 audio channels, 'quad' sound system and synchronised multitrack film score. The same system was used when I worked on Roger Waters 'The Pro's and Con's of Hitch-Hiking' tour.
